

2022 Season Recap

The 2022 Ridgefield Raptors were a team to remember. Jacob Sharp and Trent Prokes were two standout players who contributed to the team's record-setting season. Sharp, a catcher at UNLV, surprised everyone by hitting a double in his first-ever game as a Ridgefield Raptor. He followed that up with a home run and hit another home run later in the opening series. However, Sharp's performance was just one of many eye-popping totals in the box score, as the Raptors scored 41 runs in that three-game series. Nonetheless, Sharp went on to have a remarkable season, hitting a total of 14 home runs, the most in Raptors' history and in the West Coast League last season.

Trent Prokes, on the other hand, started the season off strong with a .388 batting average in the first month. Many players get hot out of the gate before leveling off, so there was a question of whether Prokes could sustain his performance. As it turns out, Prokes did more than sustain his performance. By the end of the season, he boasted a .415 batting average, the best in Raptors history, the best in the West Coast League in 2022, and the second-best in WCL history.

However, there was a bit of drama toward the end of the season when Prokes had to return to California for personal reasons. At that point, it seemed like he might not get enough plate appearances to qualify for the batting title. He went into his final game needing seven plate appearances, which was unlikely. The Raptors' offense caught fire, and Prokes kept getting at bats. Eventually, the team scored nine runs, and Prokes got six at bats through nine innings. Cowlitz came back to tie the game at 9-9, but Prokes could get a seventh plate appearance in extra innings. He was due up in the 11th inning, Cowlitz hit a long drive to left for a home run in the bottom of the 10th, resulting in a walk-off loss. It seemed like Prokes had missed his chance at the batting title. However, about two weeks later, Prokes was able to return to Ridgefield and play in the final game of the regular season, thus getting his required number of plate appearances.


Both Sharp and Prokes were outstanding players who contributed to the Raptors' record-setting season. Sharp's incredible performance at the plate earned him All-West Coast League CO-MVP honors as an outfielder/catcher. Prokes, meanwhile, earned the batting title with his .415 average and a second-team All-WCL selection.

The offense didn't stop at Prokes and Sharp. The 2022 lineup hammered 40 home runs, the most in franchise history, with 7 players hitting above .300. In the span of 73 days, the 2022 Raptors played in 57 WCL games, won 32 of them, and went on the deepest post season run in history. It truly was a summer to remember in Ridgefield.

Most home runs in a game: 4. Both on July 30 and August 1, a 17-2 win and a 9-8 win vs Walla Walla, respectively. The second game included a walkoff home run by John Peck.

Most strikeouts by Raptors pitchers in a game: 18. July 1, 2021 vs Bellingham in an 8-5 win.

Most hits in a game by one player: 6. Caden Connor on August 1, 2021 in a 9-8 win vs Walla Walla. Broke previous record of four.

Most doubles in a game by a player: 4. Set twice in 2021: Coby Morales on June 30, 2021 in a 15-10 win vs Bellingham, and John Peck on June 10, 2021 in a 10-9 win vs Portland.

Most home runs in a game by a player: 2. John Peck, Will Chambers, Kody Darcy, Jacob Sharp, and Safea Villaruz-Mauai all had multi-home run games in the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

Most RBIs by a player in a game: 6. John Peck, July 30, 2021 in a 17-2 win vs Walla Walla. Had 5 RBIs by the second inning to tie the record, added an RBI triple later.

Most hits by a player in a season: 63. Caden Connor, 2021. John Peck also broke record with 58.

Most doubles by a player in a season: 20. Caden Connor led the WCL & broke the Raptors record of 12.

Most RBIs by a player in a season: 51, Caden Connor. Also led the WCL and was the only player in the league with more than 40.

Best batting average in a season: .415, Trent Prokes, league leader in 2022.
